****A Note on Roberts Rules of Order****

All Newbold Neighbors Association meetings will be conducted following Roberts Rules of Order Newly Revised. This is a well-accepted parliamentary procedure used by groups large and small all over the country. A copy of this book can be found in many branches of the Free Library under call number: 060.42 R54r5, or in book stores.

In order to participate in the meeting, you will need to follow some basic procedures:

- Address the officers as “Madame President,” “Mr. Vice President,” “Madame Secretary,” etc.
- You must stand in order to be recognized.
- Please do not speak unless you have the floor.
- If you would like the group to consider an action, you must make a motion, stating “I move that...” followed by a specific proposal.
- When debating a motion, each participant may speak a maximum of two times for up to 10 minutes each time.
- When debating, please stick to the subject and debate the issues, not personalities.
- Remember, we are all in this together, so be respectful of your neighbors.
