What is Zoning?

Zoning is intended to prevent uses (and structures) from being incompatible. In Philadelphia, zoning regulates use, building type, signage, density, height, coverage, setbacks & parking.

****A Note on Roberts Rules of Order****

All Newbold Neighbors Association meetings will be conducted following Roberts Rules of Order Newly Revised. This is a well-accepted parliamentary procedure used by groups large and small all over the country. In order to participate in the meeting, you will need to follow some basic procedures:

- Please do not speak unless you have the floor.
- If you would like the group to consider an action, you must make a motion, stating "I move that..." followed by a specific proposal.
- When debating a motion, each participant may speak a maximum of two times for up to 10 minutes each time.
- When debating, please stick to the subject and debate the issues, not personalities.
- If you'd like to add an item to the agenda, please contact the President prior to the meeting. You can also add an agenda item during the meeting by making a motion to do so before the agenda is adopted.
- Remember, we are all in this together, so be respectful of your neighbors.
